Spiritual Thought

Lent begins with our making a firm decision both to give up something and to take on something extra. We give up to make space for God, and we take on something holy to allow him to act. However, as soon as a decision is made, voices rise against us. These voices can be around us "too extreme, no fun, what the point?" or can be voices within us "you're too weak, God doesn't want this, maybe there's something easier, do you think you're a saint already?". These are temptations.

Temptations come to us as the voice of reason, as the middle-road, as the easy way, as what 'everyone else is doing'. They make us want to fit in and hide.

But no one was made a saint by hiding, giving in, fitting in. We can overcome our temptations if we remember why we practice lent (as an offering to God) and keep our eyes on the one who was called us. Let us be strong in the Lord, and he will be strong within us.
